

## **Rules and Regulations for prajnaa 2008**

- 1) Campers are not allowed to leave the campsite unless accompanied by a counselor or by the parent/guardian (after taking permission from the counselor if in between the camp)
- 2) Possession or use of alcoholic beverages, drugs or tobacco products in the campsite will not be permitted.
- 3) Camper's luggage will be inspected prior to the beginning of the camp, to ensure that no material prohibited in the camp is brought to the camp.
- 4) Gambling, fighting, harassment of other participants, use of indecent or threatening language shall not be permitted.
- 5) Campers will stay in their allotted cabins. Boys and girls are not allowed in each other's cabins at any time.
- 6) Campers are expected to be in their rooms and quiet from 11 pm – 6 am.
- 7) Campers are expected to dress and conduct in a way suitable to the campsite atmosphere
- 8) Campers are expected to keep the campsite clean at all times. This includes the cabins, kitchen area, dining area, activity areas and the playgrounds.
- 9) Campers are expected to be considerate and courteous towards the campsite staff and others.
- 10) All campers must participate in all the activities planned for them unless excused by their counselor.
- 11) No electronic devices are permitted in the classroom. Those students wishing to record the class need to obtain permission their counselor or teacher beforehand.
- 12) Campers should adhere to all the rules explained by counselors during the camp.
- 13) Campers with any medical problems requiring special medical attention / medication must inform their counselor immediately upon arrival.
- 14) Campers experiencing any medical problems during the camp are expected to consult with a counselor immediately.
- 15) Campers are required to be present for any scheduled check-in set by counselors.
- 16) Parents/Guardians are responsible for transportation to/from the campsite during arrival to/departure from the camp. If Pick up or drop off is needed for the participant, parent/guardian should coordinate it with the camp organizers
- 17) Campers are expected to comply with all state laws on and around the campsite.
- 18) Campers must attend all classes, activities, or extra-sessions as prescribed by teachers. Missing any of these will not be tolerated unless prior permission is obtained from the teacher/ counselor

**Failure to comply with any of the rules/regulations will result in immediate expulsion from the camp. (Parents will be responsible for taking their children back in that case)**
